TICKET REFUND & CREDIT POLICY: Refund requests will be entertained on a case by case basis.





What To Expect Upon Arrival

As you prepare to experience an exciting evening of live entertainment, we hope this page will help you navigate our facility.



Here are a few tips to make your arrival go smoothly:

- Arrive early enough to get a good parking spot. If you have general admission tickets, we recommend arriving a ½ hour early to get a good seat.
- Our box office opens 1 hour before showtime. Auditorium doors open a 1/2 hour before show time.
- Use the main entrance to pick up tickets at the box office.
- Use either entrance if you already have tickets. Entrance near waterfront is closest to the auditorium.
- Washrooms are located in the hall across from the auditorium bar. A gender-neutral washroom is available.
- Concession items are available at the bars. Items can be brought into the auditorium for your enjoyment. Please dispose of garbage at the end of the event.

Making Your Visit Comfortable

We strive to make you feel welcome and your visit enjoyable. Contact the Box Office in advance if we can support you in any of these ways:

Wheelchair Access

A platform lift, located behind the Accessibility Assistance Check-In sign near the main bar, provides access to the main theatre floor for those requiring mobility assistance. We can reserve floor seating near the lift for your convenience. Three wheelchair spaces with companion seating are available at the back of the theatre.



Hearing Assistance

We have a modern and easy to use hearing-assist system. Hearing assist devices must be pre-booked. They can be picked up at the Accessibility Assistance Check-In Corner near the bar. Headphones provided or bring your own. Contact us to learn if your hearing aid can connect directly.



Vision Support

Seating can be arranged through the box office closer to the stage or near the back for those with specific vision needs. Volunteers trained to assist visually impaired patrons are available with advance notice.



Cardholders are eligible for a complimentary companion ticket. Please register your Access2 card with our box office.

Health Concerns & Group Seating

For social anxiety or other health concerns, contact the box office. and we'll help find suitable seating. Groups of 6+ with General Admission tickets can request reserved seating in advance.

Please inform our volunteers upon arrival if accommodations have been arranged—they're here to help!
