Singer/songwriter Tara MacLean's extraordinary career began on a BC ferry and led to touring with Lilith Fair. In her bestselling memoir Song of the Sparrow, she shares how music helped her survive a childhood marked by poverty and danger. Raised in rural Prince Edward

Island, Tara found solace in nature, her father's music, and her mother's love. But she also faced threats from trusted circles.
