STAGE INFORMATION

LOADING

There is a loading bay on the south end of the building, closest to the water. It is best accessed through the parking lot east of the building. The loading bay is at stage level, about 2.5 feet above ground level.

Door Dimensions: Loading Bay Door- 10' (H) x 11'8" (W) Loading Bay to Stage- 10'(H) x 7'6" (W)

Proscenium Opening: Width: 53' (fixed walls) Height: 16' (fixed hung border)

Wing Space: Stage Left: Little to no useable wing space. Stage Right: Approx. 12'(W) x 24' (D) Loading Bay: Dimensions: 18' (W) x 12'(D)

Stage Dimensions:

Upstage Wall to Downstage Edge: 26'1" Upstage Wall to Main Curtain Line: 22'10" Backdrop Line to Downstage Edge: 22' Backdrop Line to Main Curtain Line: 18'10" Main Curtain Line to Downstage Edge: 3'3" Centre Line to Stage Right Wall: 39' Centre Line to Stage Left Wall. 30'

SOFT GOODS

The main curtain is a centre-split traveler, opened and closed by hand-pulled rope offstage at stage right.

The upstage backdrop can consist of either a centre-split black drop or a full-width white drop. There are four 15-foot-tall x 7-foot-wide legs on either side of the stage. They are each mobile on a track for custom placement.

With masking in place, there is a 4-foot-wide crossover area upstage of the backdrop, and the viewable performance area is approximately 40' (W) x 22' (D).

DRESSING ROOMS

There are two large dressing rooms, lockable, each measuring 13'x13', each with an attached bathroom, and equipped with lighted mirrors.

Please note there are no showers in the building.

LIMITED MOBILITY ACCESS

Stage access: The deCoste is equipped with a ramp leading from the lobby level to stage level.

Auditorium access: There is a lift for wheelchairs and those with limited mobility which gives access from the lobby level to the auditorium floor. The topmost level of seating is at lobby level, so those patrons using wheelchairs can access seating there as well.
